

The BC Care Aide & Community Health Worker Registry's mandate is to serve and protect vulnerable patients, clients and residents and to improve standards of care.

To work for a BC health care employer receiving public funds, all care aides and community health workers (also known as health care assistants or HCAs) are required to register. Registered HCAs need to verify / update their accounts annually to maintain active status.
