

Vaccine Information for Health Care Workers

B.C. is moving forward with the [provincial COVID-19 Immunization Plan](#). Health care workers who interact with patients and clients and who work in patient or client care settings are among those now eligible to receive the COVID-19 vaccine.

The COVID-19 vaccines that have been [approved by Health Canada](#) are safe, effective and save lives.
